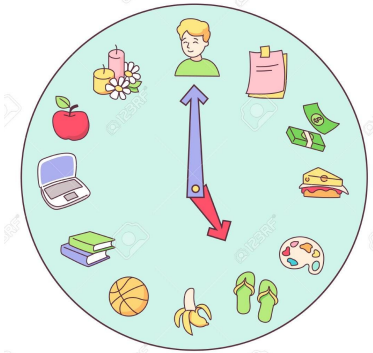

❑ Daily Expectations

Attendance Policy

Fourth Grade Expectations

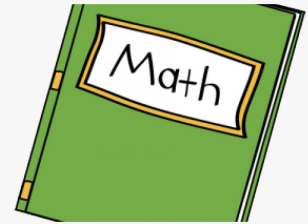
❑ Daily Expectations

- ❑ Participation will be assessed daily.
- ❑ Each student should have a hard pencil case that stays at school. This will be used **daily**. The pencil case should include 4 sharpened pencils, coloring supplies and post-it notes.
- ❑ Computers are needed **daily**.
- ❑ No items in the classroom can be shared (ex: tissues, pencils, coloring supplies, etc.)
- ❑ All students **must** stay in their personal area throughout the day to ensure social distancing.
- ❑ All online work is due by the end of the school day that it was assigned.

Math Expectations

Math Homework

- ❑ Study Multiplication Facts 10 minutes **per night. Multiplication quizzes every two weeks.**
- ❑ Homework will be given daily remotely on Google Classroom
- ❑ Receive Notice (Mid & Post-Assessments)
- ❑ Nearpod and Flipgrid will be used for distance learning live instruction.
 - Usernames and passwords will be provided on Google Classroom.

- ELA Homework
 - Read AT LEAST 20 minutes per night.
 - Homework can be found on Google Classroom. Homework will be given on Monday's and will be due that Friday.
